### Presidents Welcome & 'Year in Review':

1. Kim reviewed 2019 TMRCC accomplishments.
2. Kim presented Denny Heckman with a **Certificate of Recognition** for **Outstanding Service to all TMRCC Members**.
3. Kim strongly urged all members to respond to the AMA regarding ongoing government legislation that requires all drones weighing more than 0.5 lbs in this country will be required to have onboard telemetry to enable radar facilities to track the use of multi-rotor drones. The drone is an unmanned aircraft - guess what, so is an RC plane. There is only a 60 day window (started December 26, 2019) for comment to the FAA regarding this proposed rule.

### Current State of TMRCC:

1. We have 28 members on our roster, consisting of 25 adults, 3 youth.
