- VI. Safety Report - Dick Banken
 - a. Importance of 'Throttle Cut On'. Zero Tolerance at TMRCC. Dick stated that 'Throttle Cut On' boundaries will be expanded in the future.
 - b. Crashing in the Indian reservation area.
 - i. Before you enter, call the 'admin' phone number found on our bulletin board
 - ii. Do not get into confrontations with reservation folks which could jeopardize our MAC lease.
 - iii. Bill Walden recently followed the procedure and his plane was returned. They were very cordial and gracious.
